
WHAT TO REMEMBER WHEN INJECTING

Before you begin, ensure you have read all of the Patient Information Leaflet supplied with your Erelzi® pre-filled syringe. PIL,p1 Before injecting, wash your hands well with soap and water. PIL,p14 Using a circular motion, clean the injection site with an alcohol wipe. PIL,p19 Leave it to dry before injecting. PIL,p19 Do not touch the cleaned area before injecting. PIL,p19




- Carefully pull the needle cap straight off to remove it from the syringe^{PIL,p15} (see Figure A)
- Discard the needle cap^{PIL,p15}
- You may see a drop of liquid at the end of the needle. This is normal^{PIL,p15}



- Gently pinch the skin at the injection sitePIL,p15 (see Figure B)
- Insert the needle into your skin as shown PIL,p15
- Push the needle all the way in to ensure that the medication can be fully administered^{PIL,p15}



- Hold the syringe as shown. Slowly press the plunger as far as it will go, so that the plunger head is completely between the needle guard wings^{PIL,p15} (see Figure C)
- Keep the plunger pressed fully down while you hold the syringe in place for 5 seconds^{PIL,p15}



 Keep the plunger pressed fully down while you carefully lift the needle straight out from the injection site and let go of your skin^{PIL,p15} (see Figure D)



- Slowly release the plunger and allow the needle guard to cover the exposed needle^{PIL,p16} (see Figure E)
- There may be a small amount of blood at the injection site. PIL.p16
 You can press a cotton ball or gauze onto the injection site and hold it for 10 seconds. PIL.p16 Do not rub the injection site. PIL.p16 You may cover the injection site with a small adhesive bandage, if needed PIL.p16



- Dispose of the used syringe in a sharps container. PIL.p16 For your safety and health and that of others, needles and used syringes must never be re-used PIL.p16 (see Figure F)
- Do not throw away any medicines via wastewater or household waste. PIL.p11 Ask your doctor or pharmacist how to throw away medicines you no longer usePIL.p11

The syringe has a needle guard that will be activated to automatically cover the needle after the injection has finished. PIL.p13.p16 If you press down the plunger as far as it will go to fully deliver your injection, the needle guard will activate after the injection has finished PIL.p15 and the plunger is released. PIL.p16



SELF-INJECTION GUIDE

It is important not to try to inject yourself until you have been trained by your doctor, nurse or pharmacist. PIL,p12


Read these instructions before injecting, PIL, P12 as well as the Patient Information Leaflet provided with Erelzi®. PIL They will help you to inject correctly using the Erelzi® pre-filled syringe. PIL,p16



It is important that you:


- Do not open the outer box until you are ready to use the syringePIL,p13
- Store your outer carton of syringes in a refrigerator, between 2°C and 8°CPIL,p11
- **Do not use** the syringe if the seals of the blister are broken, as it may not be safe for you to use^{PIL,p13}
- Never leave the syringe unattended where others might tamper with it^{PIL,p13}
- **Do not shake** the syringe^{PIL,p13}
- Do not remove the needle cap until just before you give the injection PIL,p13
- If you drop your syringe, do not use it if it looks damaged, or if you dropped it with the needle cap removed PIL,p17
- Be careful **not to touch** the needle guard wings before use PIL,p13 Touching them may cause the needle guard to be activated too early^{PIL,p13}
- Throw away the used syringe right after use. PIL,p13 Do not throw away the used syringe with your household waste. Pllp13 Do not re-use a syringe

A new and unused Erelzi® pre-filled syringe

PIL,p12



Alcohol swab (not included) Cotton ball or gauze (not included)

Sharps disposal container (not included)

WHERE TO INJECT

- The recommended injection site is the front of your thighs. PIL,p14 You may also use the lower abdomen, but not the area 5 cm around your navel (belly button)PIL,p14
- Choose a different site each time you give yourself an injection^{PIL,p14}
- Do not inject into areas where the skin is tender, bruised, red, scaly, or hard. PIL,p14 Avoid areas with scars or stretch marks. PIL,p14 If you have psoriasis, you should NOT inject directly into areas with psoriasis plaques PIL,p14



PIL.p14

Before injecting

- For a more comfortable injection, PIL,p17 take the blister containing the syringe out of the refrigerator and leave it unopened for 15 to 30 minutes so that it reaches room temperature PIL,p14
- Take the syringe out of the blister PIL,p14
- Look through the viewing window. PIL,p14 The solution should be clear or slightly opalescent, colorless, or slightly yellowish. PIL,p14 It may contain small white or almost transparent particles of protein. PIL,p14 Do not use the solution if it is discolored, cloudy, or if particles other than those described above are present^{PIL,p15}
- Do not use the syringe if it is broken or the needle guard is activated PIL,p12&p15
- Look at the expiration date (EXP) on your syringe. PIL,p11 Do not use the syringe if the expiration date has passed^{PIL,p11}
