WHAT TO REMEMBER WHEN INJECTING

Before you begin, ensure you have read all of the Patient Information Leaflet supplied with your Erelzi^{®, PIL,p1} Before injecting, wash your hands well with soap and water. ^{PIL,p19} Using a circular motion, clean the injection site with an alcohol wipe.^{PIL,p19} Leave it to dry before injecting.^{PIL,p19} Do not touch the cleaned area before injecting.^{PIL,p19}

• **Twist** off the cap in the direction of the arrows^{PIL,p19} (see Figure A) Once removed, throw away the cap.^{PIL,p19} Do not try to re-attach the cap^{PIL,p19} • Use the pen within 5 minutes of removing the cap^{PIL,p19}

• Hold the pen at **90°** to the cleaned injection site^{PIL,p20} (see Figure B)

- Press the pen firmly against the skin to start the injection.^{PIL,p20} Keep holding the pen firmly against your skin^{PIL,p20} (see Figure C)
- During injection you will hear two clicks^{PIL,p20}
- First click: the injection has **started**PIL,p20 - Second click: the injection is almost finished^{PIL,p20}



- The green indicator shows the progress of the injection^{PIL,p20}
- Listen for the second click.^{PIL,p21} This indicates the injection is almost complete^{PIL,p21} (see Figure D)
- Check that the green indicator fills the window and has stopped movingPIL,p21
- The pen can now be removed^{PIL,p21}
- After injection, check that the green indicator fills the window.^{PIL,p21} This means the medicine has been delivered.^{PIL,p21} Contact your doctor if the green indicator is not visible^{PIL,p21}
- There may be a small amount of blood at the injection site.^{PIL,p21} You can press a cotton ball or gauze onto the injection site and hold it for 10 seconds.^{PIL,p21} Do not rub the injection site.^{PIL,p21} You may cover the injection site with a small adhesive bandage, if needed^{PIL,p21}
- Dispose of the used pen in a sharps container.^{PIL,p22} For your safety and health and that of others, pens must never be re-used^{PIL,p16} (see Figure E)
- Do not throw away any medicines via wastewater or household waste.^{PIL,p11} Ask your doctor or pharmacist how to throw away medicines you no longer usePIL,p11



SELF-INJECTION GUIDE

INJECTING WITH THE ERELZI® SENSOREADY® PEN

It is important not to try and inject yourself until you have been trained by your doctor, nurse or pharmacist.^{PIL,p16}

Read these instructions **before** injecting, as well as the Patient Information Leaflet provided with Erelzi[®].^{PIL,p16} They will help you to inject correctly using the Erelzi[®] SensoReady[®] pen.^{PIL,p16}



It is important that you:

- Do not remove the cap until you are ready to inject^{PIL,p19}
- Store the pen in a refrigerator between 2°C and 8°C $^{\text{PIL},\text{p17}}$
- Take the pen out of the refrigerator 15 to 30 minutes before injecting^{PIL,p17}
- Do not freeze or shake the pen^{PIL,p17}
- If you drop your pen, do not use it if it looks damaged, or if you dropped it with the cap removed^{PIL,p17}
- Throw the pen away straight after use.^{PIL,p13} Do not throw away the used pen with your household waste.^{PIL,p16} **Do not re-use the pen**^{PIL,p22}

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

WHERE TO INJECT

- The recommended injection site is the front of your thighs.^{PIL,p18}
 You may also use the lower abdomen, but not the area
 5 cm around your navel (belly button)^{PIL,p18}
- Choose a different site each time you give yourself an injection^{PIL,p18}
- Do not inject into areas where the skin is tender, bruised, red, scaly, or hard.^{PIL,p18} Avoid areas with scars or stretch marks.^{PIL,p18} If you have psoriasis, you should NOT inject directly into areas with psoriasis plaques^{PIL,p18}



Before injecting

- For a more comfortable injection, take your pen out of the refrigerator 15 to 30 minutes before injecting Erelzi® PIL,p17
- Look through the viewing window.^{PIL,p17} The solution should be clear or slightly opalescent, colorless, or slightly yellowish.^{PIL,p17} It may contain small white or almost transparent particles of protein.^{PIL,p17} Do not use the solution if it is discolored, cloudy, or if particles other than those described above are present^{PIL,p18}
- Look at the expiration date (EXP) on your pen.^{PIL,p18} Do not use your pen if the expiration date has passed^{PIL,p18}
- Do not use if the safety seal has been broken^{PIL,p18}
